

The AKC Gazette Committee Chairperson

The GOAL of the chairperson is to write quarterly articles for the AKC Gazette that are specific to German Pinschers and meet the Gazette's deadlines for publication. The articles are to be informational and educational for AKC Judges, potential judges, and the inquiring public. All accepted and published articles become the copyright property of AKC.

AKC encourages articles from 'guest' breed columnists that conform to AKC's stated guidelines. A guest columnist must sign and submit a release authorizing publication of his/her article(s).

The articles may not be advertisements for specific kennels or people therein.

All articles submitted to AKC for publication in the Gazette must receive official approval from the GPCA Board of Directors prior to submission to AKC. To obtain Board approval, the Gazette Chairperson must submit the article to the Board at least 14 days prior to requiring approval.

Committee chairs must submit a quarterly report each quarter for publication in the Pinscher Press as per the deadline dates established in the Pinscher Press guidelines. If no committee action has occurred during a quarter that should also be reported. The yearly report required for the annual membership meeting will count as one of the quarterly reports.

By the authority of the GPCA Constitution/Bylaws, any committee member who does not follow these guidelines may be terminated by a majority vote of the full membership of the Board upon written notice to the appointee; and the Board may appoint a successor for the person whose service has been terminated.
