

## Description and Duties of the Supported Entry Committee

As stated in the constitution/Bylaws, this committee shall always be subject to the final authority of the GPCA Board of Directors. The Board can appoint new members to the committee, appoint the chairman, and will approve members wishing to join this committee in the future.

**Goal:** Encourage and facilitate GPCA member supported entries shows.

**Purpose:** Encourage supported entries to increase the attendance at kennel club shows thereby creating points and majors for the participants.

The duties of the committee follow:

1. Maintain a supported entry application.
2. Coordinate applications for supported entries to ensure that they appropriate as indicated.
3. Encourage members of GPCA to apply for and support shows.
4. If German Pinscher Supporters promise trophies to the kennel club for a "Supported Entry", ensure that the supporters provide the trophies. Contact the Show Chairperson or Trophy Chairperson so that the Show Chair lists "Supported Entry" and the trophies in the Premium List.
5. Keep the GPCA Board informed of activities of the committee.
6. The Committee Chairman must present an annual report to the Board prior to the Annual Meeting as required by the GPCA Constitution/Bylaws.

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By the authority of the GPCA Constitution/Bylaws, any committee member who does not follow these guidelines may be terminated by a majority vote of the full membership of the Board upon written notice to the appointee; and the Board may appoint a successor for the person whose service has been terminated.
